LOCAL GUIDELINES ARE:


- 1. No use of turbo trainers within 100metres of inhabited property.

COURSE DETAILS:

Please note: START is a 5-10 minute ride from headquarters depending on how fast you want your warm up to be!

Please note that the law dictates that free wheeled cycles are fitted with BOTH front and rear brake in good working order. Fixed wheel cycles require front brake in good working order. Sorry but riders not complying with this will not be allowed to start.

The course starts opposite Maynard's Nursery and finishes just before the car park at the top of the bank a total distance of 1.55 miles (see map and profile).
