Introduction & History

FAB Racing League began in 1997 – founded by Stephen Binks & Norman Bielby. Rebranded as the League 2000 in the year 2000.

From 1997 – 2010, it was held at Teesside Autodrome, until Middlesbrough Sports Village Cycle Circuit was built for the 2011 season onwards (excluding 2020), our current home.

The series started with 6 rounds (1997), then 8 (1998 – 2000, 2021) and then 12 (best of 10) (2001 – 2019, 2022 - 2023). The current format sees us run 10 (best of 8) from 2024 onwards.

The series entry fee started at £2 per round (1997 – 2002), £3 (2003 – 2014), £4 (2015 – 2016) and since 2017, it has remained at £5 which is the current entry fee.

Over the years, a League 2000 team was formed to keep up with the League's popularity. This continues to grow and evolve year on year.



2025 - Statistics

- 2025 28th Edition of the League 2000
- 10 rounds running between March July 2025
- 95 riders registered, with 90 taking part in at least one round, represented by CWCC, SWCC, Manilla, Hetton Hawks & Billingham South
- 585 total rides with an average 59 a night, across the 10 rounds
- Round 3 saw the highest attendance at 67, whilst Round 10 saw the lowest with 47
- Nearly £1000 has been awarded in prize money across the series, with an additional £500 spent on goodies and chocolates as prizes
- Over £500 was spent on Trophies & Medals this year
