It's demanding and riders ought to have had experience riding in League 2000 before having a go. Older Riders would find Thursday's TDC sessions run by North East coaches from across the region, ideal preparation for these races. Whilst younger riders may find the CWCC All-Stars sessions on a Thursday ideal for race preparation for these events.

A race licence is required. Apply through British Cycling's website & this should be free for the first year for all club members.

Would be wise to warm up prior to races – rollers/turbos can be borrowed if required

with children, adults and tandems taking part. Young children and first timers can be chaperoned if necessary.

We'd recommend these events for any ability.

At the end of the season, there are boys and girls rankings.

Its good training and a great atmosphere.

Event starts at 6 30. Entries close at 6 30. It's wise to be there at least 45 mins before to get an early number.

The track is open to warm up beforehand, but rollers and turbos can be borrowed from the club for warmups too.

Entering its 29th year, the League 2000 will continue to be the powerhouse of grassroots cycling in the north east. We would massively encourage everyone to enter and attend each round.

It's a great, friendly fun youth racing series in a supportive environment, incorporating fun elements whilst still providing that competitive edge.

You will need to register on the website **once** for the full season and then turn up at each round and pay to take part on that given evening.

There is a skills event, a time trial and handicapped (according to ability) road races.

There are cash prizes for race winners, most improved time trial and combativity (best skills course result).

Over the season, riders accumulate points towards end of season prizes in U6, U8, U10, U12, U14, U16 and O16 categories. So, the more races you enter, the better your chances of winning are.

R2.1.7. Youth Cycles

R2.1.7.1. Riders shall be restricted to a maximum gear such that the distance covered per crank revolution is as shown in the following table:

CATEGORY	ROAD RACING
Youth A	7.18 metres
Youth B	6.73 metres
Youth C	6.34 metres
Youth D	Unrestricted
Youth E	Unrestricted

R2.1.7.2. Before an Event, gear checks must be performed on the equipment of all riders subject to gear restrictions. Supplementary gear checks should take place after the Event.

R2.1.7.3. Cycles used by riders in Youth B and younger categories for any Road Events (including Scottish Time Trial Events) must:

R2.1.7.3.1. have wheels with:
